Regarding reviewer 00646502 comments on a control group usefulness towards confirming the results, we'd like to stress that such an study has already been conducted by Dr L Rosenberg et al (A novel rapid and selective enzymatic debridement agent for burn wound management: a multi-center RCT. Burns 2014; 40: 466-74. [PMID: 24074719 DOI: 10.1016/j.burns.2013.08.013]. Since we are dealing with a treatment with proven efficacy, we believe that having a control group is not necessarily a requisite. The aim of this article is to show our learning curve and comment upon the caveats that might ease and facilitate the application of the aforementioned treatment in other institutions.
