We have revised the review article. The revisions are shown in red colour and underlined. The words that can not be changed are highlighted as yellow. According to these revisions:

1- You had highlighted “key words”. But we couldn’t change these words, because there are no other words that we can use instead of this. This is not plagiarism.

2- In the sixth page, in the 26th line, we couldn’t change the term “from Sertoli cell only syndrome to”. We don’t know how we can change this term.

3- In the ninth page, in the 33rd line, we don’t know how we can change “this” and “by” words. So we couldn’t change them.
