In this study, the antibiotic should be used. However, there is not a mention about the antibiotic which I used. It is necessary to list it what kind of antibiotic you used.

→Thank you for your kind advice for improving the quality of our manuscript. In accordance with your advice, we have added detail of the antibiotics to the MATERIALS AND METHODS section and Table 2.

(Reviewer 2)

It's remain to understand the role of AT in this condition.

→Our present univariate analysis identified only the use of rTM as a factor contributing to successful DIC treatment, while AT was not identified as such a factor. As for our results, I consider that rTM is more effective than AT. However, further studies are needed to determine the usefulness of AT because the value of serum ATIII was not examined in this study. We could not solve the details of serum ATIII levels because of the property of retrospective study. We have added this description to the DISCUSSION section.


As a minor point, I would suggest a linguistic revision.
