1 Although single-balloon enteroscopy with N-butyl-2-cyanoacrylate and lipiodol injection for varicose veins had been reported before, it was a rare circumstance that the jejunal varices came from superior mesenteric venous thrombosis and protein C deficiency. This case report reminds us that the cause of obscure gastrointestinal bleeding should be carefully evaluated for adequate management.
