The manuscript has been made according to the suggestions of the editor and reviewers:

1. Format has been updated
2. Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the editor and the reviewers. The changes made for the revised manuscript were highlighted by yellow color.
 - (1) [G1]<90 was replaced by [G1] >90
 - (2) The whole volume of the section “Risk factors of CKD in HIV-infected patients” was shortened.
 - (3) A new table (Table 2) was made, describing glomerular and tubulointerstitial lesions associated with HIV infection and some antiretroviral drugs.
 - (4) The section “Summary” was shortened and changed to “Key message”.
 - (5) In Table 2 (ex-Table 1), “(+)” after the word “Diabetes mellitus”, “Hypertension” and “HCV coinfection” was deleted.
 - (6) Figure 2 (ex-Figure 3), for the algorithm of CKD care, was newly constructed in the revised version.
3. All abbreviations in the text were listed before the section of abstract.
4. Eight key words were put after the section of abstract.
5. Core tip within 100 words was written after “key words”.
6. All original figures and tables are supposed to be decomposable.
7. The revised manuscript was newly edited by a professional English speaker and the PDF of certificate was added.
8. References with PMID and DOI and typesetting were corrected according to the suggestions of the editor. Reference no. [67] has not been indexed by PubMed, so its PDF file was attached.
