We have studied comments carefully and have made correction which we hope meet with approval. Revised portion are marked in red in the paper. The main corrections in the paper and the responds to the reviewer's comments are as following:

Replies to Reviewer Questions:

1 This interesting manuscript about alcohol consumption and BE is interesting for the readership and should be published. However, the conclusion stating that alcohol consumption increases the incidence of BE can not be made. The discussion nicely highlights the problems with a wide variation on confounding factors. The heterogeneity of the different studies is too big in order to compare and draw conclusions.

Answer: Thank you very much for the suggestion. Actually, our results have demonstrated that there was statistically significant heterogeneity among these studies ($P=0.017$). In order to eliminate the heterogeneity of these studies, we have conducted the subgroup analysis in different study type, country, source and alcohol type.

2 Figure 1 does not contribute to the results and should be omitted.

Answer: Thank you very much for the suggestion. We have deleted the Figure 1. Corrections have been made in the revised version.
