[ ] Page 7 - Line 3 & 4: Place in parentheses (VA) following "The Veterans Affairs (VA) National Hepatitis C Resource Center....". Your 3rd paragraph on this page starts with "The VA..." so identifying the abbreviation beforehand will clarify its reference.

[ ] Page 8 - Lines 1, 2 & 7: Three sentences begin with "So...". You may want to replace these leaders with "Thus" or "Therefore" or reconfigure the sentences to avoid "So".

These parts of the manuscript have been revised to follow the reviewer suggestions. I have been able to revise the paper so that "so" is not used at all in this way. These changes have been highlighted in the revised manuscript.

References have been completed per journal requirements, including PMID and DOI number.

A running head has been added.

City, State, and Zip have been added.

A core tip has been added.
