The manuscript has been improved according to the suggestions of reviewers:

2 Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the reviewer

- (1) The title should read: ...liver injury: The first case report worldwide.
Title is updated.
- (2) The text requires re-writing. It appears that the present case of LC hepatotoxicity actually is the first case published in the literature worldwide.
Manuscript is re-written according to the suggestion.
- (3) The first para should start that numerous herbs may be hepatotoxic
Text was added with appropriate references.
- (4) It should be mentioned that Greater Celandine is potentially hepatotoxic
Text was added with appropriate references.
- (5) For both kinds of Celandine you should provide references for their individual use. Then you continue with: We now present a case
Text was added according to the suggestion.
- (6) Please clarify in the text, how LC was used. Topical? As tea?
The usage of LC was clarified.
- (7) Second para: Please correct: consumption. Laboratory values, please include normal ranges
Laboratory values for autoimmune tests were added and normal values for liver function tests were given.
- (8) A table with CIOMS items and scores for the individual patient should be included
Table was added as suggested.
- (9) Clarify how types of liver injury are assessed and provide references.
References provided and type of liver injury assessment was further explained.
- (10) Your patient did not receive a liver biopsy, this is ok. You should mention this and reference that liver histology is not essential for diagnosis.
The reason why our patient did not have a biopsy was explained and references were given.
- (11) Autoimmune markers are all negative is not acceptable. It needs to be indicated which one has been used
Names of all autoimmune markers that were used are given.

(12)The sentence "Our case underscores that physicians should consider lesser celandine as a causative agent for hepatotoxicity" is not clear.

The sentence was better formulated.

(13)English needs improvement.


Manuscript was reviewed and corrected by a native speaker of English.
