1. The reviewer's comment: the pictures of POEM can combine figure 1 and figure 4 together, to show the effect of POEM more clearly.

1. The reviewer's comment: Although it is well written, concerns were raised with regard to the lack of novelty when compared to the recent publications from China. This seems to be a study to confirm the safety and feasibility of POEM for patients with achalasia.

Answer: Thank you for pointing this out. We have to admit that our study has its limitations. However, it has a certain degree of clinical meaning to achalasia treatment.

2. The reviewer's comment: The panels of figures should be merged.

1. The reviewer's comment: The effect of POEM on achalasia is well know. More than 14 case series of patients treated with POEM are available for review. The largest case series reported data on 300 patients.

Answer: Thank you for pointing this out. We have to admit that our study has its limitations. However, the focus of our work is on multi-dimensional evaluation of POEM efficacy, and this is also the major contribution of our work.

2. The reviewer's comment: The title of the paper should reflect results of POEM in your center

in first 50 patient. The current title is misleading.


3. The reviewer's comment: There are numerous grammatical errors in the manuscript. I understand English may not be the first language of the authors. Please have the manuscript revised.
