

Thank you for your positive evaluation. Given the available literature, no overall conclusion on which marker is better than the others is possible. I think a “final conclusion” indicating that further research on these markers should be conducted (an obvious statement) is not very useful. Language errors have been corrected.

### **Reviewer 00013213**

Thank you for your positive feedback and for taking the time to report all linguistic inaccuracies. They have been corrected (changes underlined). However you suggested some incorrect changes (“septic” means “infected”, not “septicemic”; “quintiles” is different from “quartiles”).
