- The title might be changed as the review described the importance of DWI in gynecological malignancies.

We realized that we haven't talked much about the past of DWI in our article, hence we have removed the same from the title and changed it to "Diffusion Weighted Imaging of Gynecological Malignancies- Present and Future". We feel the current title aptly describes the internal content of our article which is to describe DWI's present role and future applications in gynecological malignancies.

- The DWI protocol of MRI in pelvis should be mentioned in the form of a table.

The same has been done and a new heading “protocol” has been added along with Table 1.

- Sarcomas were discussed only in one sentence. They should be described more comprehensive in a separate title.
