Below is a response addressing comments by peer-reviewers and editor regarding the submission of the article entitled, “Radiological features of uncommon aneurysms of the cardiovascular system” to the *World Journal of Radiology*.

In response to first reviewer’s comments regarding several unexplained abbreviations, each abbreviation used more than once has been defined at the time of its first appearance in the article. Furthermore, several abbreviations provided in parentheses were removed if the phrase did not appear later in the manuscript.

Various syntax errors pointed out by several reviewers have been corrected.

In response to the third reviewer’s comment regarding traumatic aortic aneurysms, this has been included in the Ductus Aneurysm section. This section has been expanded using the suggested reference.

In response of the fourth reviewer’s comments, the subsections of the paper have been reorganized with a more logical flow between topics. Numerous sentences have been changed to reduce the verbosity of the article and improve readability and organization. Furthermore several more current references were updated or added. It should be noted that given the rarity of several of these aneurysms, more current published data is not available.
