- (1) "1) Hyperlipidemia is very common after liver transplantation(LT) and can be observed in up to 71% of cases. Occurrence of lipid disorders is multifactors such as immunosuppressive agents, increased body weight, malnutrition, abnormal renal function, impaired glucose metabolism and genetic predisposition after liver transplantation. The post-LT recipients have an approximately 64% increased risk of cardiovascular events in comparison with the general population because of hyperlipidemia. The review is very important guidance to clinical docotors who can well treat and prevent the hyperlipidemia and reduce risk factors such cardiovascular complications after liver transplantation. 2) The introduction including atherogenesis, its metabolic impact and diagnostics in hyperlipidemia should be further cut down. Tha main introduction and discussion concisely emphasize on treatment and provention of hyperlipidemia after liver transplantation."

**Comment:** The introduction including atherogenesis, its metabolic impact and diagnostics in hyperlipidemia has been significantly shortened as suggested by the reviewer. Furthermore, the text has been English edited by a native speaker (please find attached language certificate).
