### RESPONSE TO REVIEWERS

We would like to thank the reviewers for their thorough comments. The following changes have been made in accordance with their recommendations.

**Reviewer 00214291** – Thank you. No changes suggested.

**Reviewer 00227531** – The reviewer requested a reference for the recommendation for angiography, AHA respectively ESC guidelines for adults with congenital heart disease. This is found in our references 5 and 6, as cited in the introduction. We added reference 6, that is the citation for the European Guidelines to the introduction.

We were not able to follow the recommendation for the still images of the stress echocardiogram as we feel that only moving images would give the right information.

As far as prognosis of future coronary artery complications, this is unknown at present as the infants who had this operation are still only growing up. The arterial switch operation started to become more popular since the mid-1980s. Many patients are still children.

With regards to “Half of the patients have normal stress echo and abnormal ECG findings after the arterial switch operation”, there may be a slight misunderstanding. To our knowledge, there are no such studies on patients after the arterial switch operation. Therefore, we offered information on a different disease that also involves re-implantation of the coronary artery. References 9 and 10 are for that different diagnosis, “anomalous origin of the coronary artery”.

**Reviewer 00227375** – Thank you. No changes suggested.

**Reviewer 00227683** – Thank you for the comment. We changed the title to include “boy” and spelled out “LAD” as left anterior descending coronary artery.

**Reviewer 00506608:** Thank you – no changes suggested.

**Reviewer 02602138: Abstract:** *“...serial screening maximal exercise stress test...”* This was rephrased as “Therefore, since age 7 years he had a series of screening exercise stress tests. “

**Discussion, paragraph 2:** *It also allows excellent assessment of the branch pulmonary arteries following the Lecompte maneuver.* – The word “assessment” was changed to “interrogation”.

**Discussion, paragraph 3:** *“...has been employed to in...”* - redundant word removed.

**Figure legend:** *“CT angiographic views of from the...”* – redundant word removed.
