have agreed as follows:

Special conditions

Article 1 - Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this contract is the award of a grant by the Contracting Authority for the implementation of the Action entitled: **European-Asian Postgraduate Curriculum on Biomedical Imaging Research (EAPCoBIR)** ("the Action") described in Annex I.
- 1.2 The Beneficiary will be awarded the grant on the terms and conditions set out in this contract, which consists of these special conditions ("Special Conditions") and the annexes, which the Beneficiary hereby declares it has noted and accepted.
- 1.3 The Beneficiary accepts the grant and undertakes to carry out the Action under its own responsibility.

Article 2 - Implementation period of the Action

- 2.1 This contract shall enter into force on the date when the last of the two Parties signs.
- 2.2 Implementation of the Action shall begin on the first day of the month following the date on which the first instalment of prefinancing is paid by the Contracting Authority.
- 2.3 The Action's implementation period, as laid down in Annex I, is 36 months.

Article 3 - Financing the Action

- 3.1 The total cost of the Action eligible for financing by the Contracting Authority is estimated at **1.000.049,82 EURO**, as set out in Annex III.

- 3.2 The Contracting Authority undertakes to finance a maximum of **749.837,36** EURO, equivalent to **74,98%** of the estimated total eligible cost specified in paragraph 1; the final amount shall be established in accordance with Articles 14 and 17 of Annex II.
- 3.3 Pursuant to Article 14.4 of the Annex II, 7,00% (*maximum 7%*) of the final amount of direct eligible costs of the Action established in accordance with Articles 14 and 17 of the Annex II, may be claimed by the beneficiary as indirect costs.

Article 4 - Narrative and financial reporting and payment arrangements

- 4.1 Narrative and financial reports shall be produced in support of payment requests, in compliance with Articles 2 and 15.1 of Annex II.
- 4.2 Payment will be made in accordance with Article 15 of Annex II. Of the options referred to in Article 15.1, the following will apply:



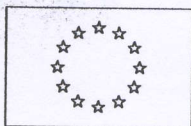



1. De ASPIRANTEN kunnen een doctoraatsopleiding volgen. Daarnaast kunnen zij andere cursussen volgen in relatie tot hun onderzoek, voor zover de afwerking van het doctoraatsproefschrift binnen de duur van het mandaat niet in het gedrang komt. De totale werklast, zowel voor het volgen van andere cursussen als voor opdrachten waarmee ze door hun promotor worden belast, bedraagt maximaal 8 uur per week. Deze opdrachten kunnen zijn: begeleiding van oefeningen, practica of seminars, waarvoor de werklast dubbel wordt geteld (bvb. 1 uur seminarie = 2 uur werklast), ofwel administratieve of klinische taken. Er mogen geen leeropdrachten worden waargenomen en er mag geen lerarenopleiding worden gevolgd.
2. De POSTDOCTORAAL ONDERZOEKERS en PEGASUS LONG¹ mandaathouders kunnen door de onthaalinstelling worden belast met opdrachten waarvan de totale werklast maximaal 8 uur per week bedraagt. Deze bepaling vervalt tijdens periodes van langdurige ziekte, zwangerschaps- en borstvoedingsverlof, buitenlands verblijf, voltijds ouderschapsverlof en palliatief verlof. Deze opdrachten kunnen zijn:
 - administratieve of klinische taken;
 - begeleiding van oefeningen, practica of seminaria, waarvoor de werklast dubbel wordt geteld (1 uur oefeningen, practica of seminaria staat daarbij gelijk aan 2 uur werklast);
 - een onbezoldigde onderwijsopdracht aan een universiteit of aan een hogeschool (academische opleidingen) waarnemen die de limiet van twee jaaruur niet mag overschrijden tijdens het eerste mandaat en de limiet van drie jaaruur tijdens het tweede en het derde mandaat. In geval van een opdracht aan een hogeschool of andere universiteit moet de toestemming gevraagd worden aan de rector van de universiteit die optreedt als onthaalinstelling.

Bij een deeltijdse titularis wordt het maximum van 8 uur per week gereduceerd in verhouding tot het deeltijdse mandaat.

Houders van een postdoctoraal mandaat kan bijkomend een deeltijdse bezoldigde opdracht toevertrouwd worden aan een instelling van hoger onderwijs, op voorwaarde dat hun aanstelling als mandaathouder gereduceerd wordt in verhouding tot deze procentuele aanstelling, met inbegrip van 50% aanstellingen in het tenure track-stelsel ten laste van de universitaire werkmiddelen.

Behalve het voeren van de titel, aan hoger vermelde opdrachten verbonden, en behoudens bijzondere toelating van het Bureau van het FWO, mogen ze geen enkele andere functie uitoefenen, noch om het even welke andere benoeming aanvaarden.

¹ Deze bepalingen gelden niet voor de houders van een mandaat van het type 'Pegasus-Short'. Deze mandaathouders worden verondersteld zich voltijds aan hun onderzoeksopdracht te wijden en mogen geen enkele andere opdracht aanvaarden.
