Br J Cancer. 2016 Apr 28. doi: 10.1038/bjc.2016.70” as highlighted in yellow: “Phase II study with nab-paclitaxel/gemcitabine as 2nd-line treatment showed promising activity in patients with rapid progression (PFS less than 248 days) from FOLFIRINOX as first-line treatment [59]”.
