(1) The errors of grammar, misspelled words, neologism like hepatic-renal fossa and abbreviations like EgCF+ and ERCP have been corrected by American Journal Experts and me.

(2) All the keywords have been checked and match MeSH standard.

(3) We classified foreign bodies retained in liver as 3 categories: penetrating, medical and migrated foreign bodies. The number of literature review related to foreign bodies in other part of body was rather large whereas rare in liver. We tend to summarize migrated foreign bodies in liver and make it understand clearly and concisely by clinical doctors. Thus, we paid more attention to penetrating and medical foreign bodies in liver. Also, we have tried to shorten parts of the Discussion which are repetitive according to the reviewer's suggestion.

(4) Figures 3 and 4 have already been omitted as the reviewer suggested.

(5) The title was shortened to make it less than 12 words.
