To receive 2 positive reports from two reviewers, both with recommendation of acceptance, B classification degree (Very good) and A degree language, encourages us to go on ahead with the process. For this reason, we extend our gratitude for the work you and the reviewers have performed.

We have taken into account the editor's and reviewers' comments having replied to theirs proposals.

In this way, we have revised both Google Scholar where there are not similar records to manuscript's proposed title and Crossref with Write Check software when revising article's contents. This obtained a 3% similarity after excluding quotes and bibliography. Therefore, according to the software it has a 97% of original contents.

Nevertheless, I would like to show evidence of my nonconformity about publishing process.. In summary, it is too complex and is not at all easy to follow it. It is not recommendable the reading of tutorials so extensive with so many requirements for submitting a publication. System should have to go more directed to a innovation of its infrastructure and contents in plainness and efficacy, such as PeerJ or PlosOne models.

Regarding signature of assignment copyright, we have tried to coincide with the authors, bearing in mind that it is vacation season and it is difficult to coincide physically, mainly, with those ones being abroad.

Also having into account the notes of this document, I wish to communicate that one of the authors' name is written in a different way. Instead of Satacana Maria Forns, the text should say Maria Forns Santacana. We have allowed ourselves to make this little change, for it should go in this way.

Comments of the reviewer 00506481: The authors have reported their findings based on Ecological Momentary Assessment with Smartphones for measuring mental health problems in adolescents. The study was well taken and the results indicate that such an evaluation is helpful to assess whether using smartphones is a useful tool for assessing daily dynamics or sufficiently accurate measure of the psychopathological manifestations experienced by community adolescents. In the study of momentary states associated with mental health symptomatology over a week it was observed that in most cases adolescents do not present emotional alterations or problems in their daily life. Girls were slightly more affected in their momentary emotional status and behaviors in daily life than boys. And among the situations in which a conflict is generated – on the one hand, anxious-depressed states, and on the other the oppositional-aggressive behavior are closely inter-related. It is a useful outcome which shows that the family and home context could be crucial for the potential development of training interactions, both positive and negative, in the mental

health field, and they also stress the importance of individuals' coping resources in relation with their formative, relational, and physical context.
