I. Page 8, the lower line 8: Page 8, the lower line 6:

(answer) I corrected as follows: GA-FG-CCP may be likely to grow vertically into the submucosa and develop laterally toward the surrounding tissue.

II. Page 10, the upper line 5:

(answer) I corrected as follows: The biopsy may be needed for a lesion suggesting a submucosal or carcinoid tumor but resembling GA-FG-CCP in order to distinguish GA-FG-CCP from these tumors.

III. Page 10, the lower line 11:

(answer) I corrected as follows: The tumor originates from chief cells, which lies at the bottom of the fundic glands.
