In introduction section: the abbreviation should be given after full name of "CVA". ? The first sentence of page 7: the abbreviation should be given after full name of "UGE" ? The tables were not referred in correct order. The authors should check the tables. ? I advise to use the term "otolaryngologist" instead of "ENT surgeon" -page 11 clinical assessment section ? The authors may add a small paragraph about functional endoscopic evaluation of swallowing (FEES) in the "investigations" section. This will strengthen this review.
