1. Dear author It is necessary to correct some errors like this one: this small error: "Serum ADA levels >20 U/L were found in % 64 AIH patients and in % 0 healthy controls,  $p < 0.001$ "

It seems to me a good study, correctly developed with a suitable order. Moreover, it brings an interesting contribution to the knowledge. Comments; ? There are several punctuation errors in the text. (e.g. % 64 AIH patients) ?Remove the statement from Table 4. (Hata! Belgede belirtilen stilde metne rastlanmad?.)
