2. Reviewer 00227386

This is an interesting report of two rare cases of stomach tumours diagnosed as plexiform fibromyxoma and successfully treated by distal gastrectomy. It contains extensive details of the immunohistochemical and molecular findings which may be of technical interest only to those with specialised knowledge. These findings are accompanied by numerous abbreviations which are difficult to follow and it would be helpful if a separate glossary was included for easy reference. The English is good but there are isolated places where it is not idiomatic and needs correcting. There are places in the text where the full title needs to be given as well as the abbreviation. On page 3 "RO resection" and likewise "HPF" on page 6 need to be given in full. In the Figures the caption for Figure 1 should state that it refers to Patient No 1 and likewise that Figure No 2 refers to Patient No 2.

Replay: As suggested, separate glossary has been included in the manuscript. However, English Editing Company decided to explain all abbreviations within the manuscript (and they deleted the

glossary from the manuscript). R0 is written differently (in brackets) and HPF is given in full. Patient designations (1 and 2) are included in the Figures description.

3. Reviewer 00068458

The authors have reported and provided information useful for better understanding of plexiform fibromyxoma, a very rare mesenchymal tumor of the stomach.

4. Reviewer 02439561

You did a great study about a rare disease of the stomach. You need to correct some words or phrases, which typed in red colour on attached file. Some words or phrases in the parenthesis need to be omitted, I think. I suggest to review your manuscript by MS Words program to check the spelling or superscript in this case.
