Page 3, line 21 (1.-INTRODUCTION): arthropatic? Is that correct word? 5. Page 4, line 7: arthropathies instead of arthropaties? 6. Page 4, line 17: arthropathies instead of arthropaties? 7. Page 17, line 12: arthropathies instead of arthropaties?
