The manuscript has been improved according to the suggestions of reviewers:

1 Format has been updated

2 Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the reviewer and highlighted at yellow color in the revised manuscript

- (1) The populations were provided in Table 2
- (2) The typos have been corrected.
- (3) In figure 2, TSA was defined as MSI-L or MSS instead of MSI-H as suggested
- (4) Regarding the question raised about GCHP and *BRAF* mutation, *BRAF* mutations are more frequent than *KRAS* mutations in MVHP and SSA. On the other hand, in GCHP, *KRAS* mutations are likely the most important genetic alteration. Only one study, by Kim et al. showed higher frequencies of *BRAF* mutations than *KRAS* mutation in both MVHP and GCHP. We have stated it in the manuscript (page 9, lane 4). Sandmeier et al. have considered hyperplastic polyps as a whole and have not studied their subtypes separately.
