This drawback is mentioned by the authors at the end of the discussion. Further comments: Figure 3: Are the same section planes used in these images (A and B; C and D)? Text and figure legends: Please check the text and the figure legends once again for spelling errors (e.g., page 5, first paragraph: "aldoesterone" -> aldosterone; figure legend 1: "magnificantion" -> magnification).

This is an interesting paper looking at the use of Yttrium-90 microspheres in the management of hepatic metastases from adrenocortical carcinoma. Could the authors please respond to the following questions/comments? 1) Despite the fact that the authors show an excellent result with the use of the Yttrium-90 microspheres, the question remains whether this method/strategy is superior to the use of TACE. Also, could the authors comment on the potential financial cost/benefits between the two procedures for the management of the hepatic metastatic disease? 2) The authors may wish to broaden the discussion regarding the current literature in the use of Yttrium-90 microspheres for different hepatic metastatic lesions in order to provide a better perspective to the reader.
