In this editorial, the authors have reviewed and summarized the management of local recurrence after endoscopic resection. They have advised to perform UEMR for



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relatively small ( $\leq 10-15$  mm) recurrent lesions, and ESD for larger lesions. I think this is a well written paper although there is a few misspelling; also the figures are all appropriate.
