### SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a case report of 83 year-old man with type 2 diabetes who developed gangrenous cholecystitis (GC). The case was clinically of interest. There are some comments. 1. The authors emphasized the presence of diabetic neuropathy. However, they did not show

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any clinical diagnosis of diabetic neuropathy. Examinations of diabetic neuropathy such as deep tendon reflexes, vibratory sensation inspection, R-R interval, orthostatic hypotension and nerve conduction velocity should be assessed and described. 2. The authors described this case as “long-standing” diabetes. However, duration of diabetes was not described. Also, the condition of other micro- and macroangiopathy (nephropathy, retinopathy and cardiovascular diseases) should be described. 3. Obesity is a risk factor of gall stone. Height, weight and BMI of this case should be described. 4. Why the authors conducted a HIDA scan? CT or MRI scan may be more informative. 5. GC was confirmed by pathology? The pathological findings should be described.
