SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is an interesting paper on a rare tumor type, with some useful information to the readers. Mixed neoplasms with neuroendocrine component have been studied with extensive molecular analyses in few papers; on of the most important is this (Scardoni



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et al., PMID: 25342539), which I indicate to the authors to read and perhaps cite. On the basis of this paper, which is on gastrointestinal tumors, the Authors should discuss potential findings in applying molecular sequencing also on the study of mixed neoplasms of other organs, included larynx. The part on possible/potential therapies should be less speculative and more precise, with a better review of the literature on this specific topic. The Authors should also write a comment on the issues linked to intratumor heterogeneity and the biopsy approach: indeed, in case of small biopsies, they cannot always capture the actual nature of such tumor. Please, discuss this point adequately. I have seen many grammar errors and the english is not fluent, please improve the use of the language.
