3. Details regarding the performance (e.g. sensitivity, specificity) of several objective markers for monitoring disease activity as compared to the gold standard (colonoscopy) have been added.
4. An overview of the fundamental concepts of quality improvement i.e. continuous measurement after intervention implementation to ensure changes are an improvement, has been added.
5. Risks and unintended consequences of the proposed quality improvement initiatives are now discussed in detail.
