The manuscript has been improved according to the suggestions of reviewers:

1. In line 9 the Abstract, the missing “I” of the abbreviation IBDI was added.
2. The citations numbers 5 and 22 were eliminated. In this regard on line 18 on page 7, the paragraph was re-written (according to suggestions, the citations numbers 15 and 16 were kept): “In studies conducted in 1994 by Madariaga et al., and in the year 1996 by Majno et al., they indicated hepatectomy in cases of liver-infected necrosis”.
3. At line 20 on page 5 of the manuscript, the paragraph: “Complex injuries involving hepatic influence are frequently associated with vascular injuries, liver atrophy, long-standing cholangitis and previous failed attempts at repair.” was removed.
4. At line 5 on page 6 of the manuscript, the paragraph: “The aim of partial liver resection in patients with complex IBDI was to remove fibrotic and atrophic liver parenchyma and to perform a single biliary anastomosis, and to remove atrophic parenchyma with a high risk of secondary complication because of vascular or septic lesions.” was re-written as: “The aim of partial liver resection in patients with complex IBDI was to remove fibrotic and atrophic liver parenchyma with a high risk of secondary complications because of vascular or septic lesions.”

1. The reported indications for hepatectomy were summarized at the conclusion part of the manuscript and some descriptions in the middle part of this manuscript were deleted changing it according to suggestions of Reviewer 00503889.
