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Abstract

1 BACKGROUND

There is a small and poorly studied population of patients with mild and limited Crohn's disease (CD), who either spontaneously enter remission and can discontinue therapy, or be maintained on milder anti-inflammatory treatment.

AIM

To identify a group of children with mild CD who were not escalated to immunomodulators (azathioprine, mercaptopurine, or methotrexate) or biologics (infliximab or adalimumab) within the first two years after their Crohn's diagnosis and outline the natural history and phenotypic features of these patients.

A chronic inflammation of the digestive tract.

- Rare (Fewer than 200,000 cases per year in US)
- Diagnosis requires lab test or imaging
- Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure
- Can be lifelong

The exact cause is unknown but heredity and malfunctioning immune system play a role. Common symptoms include abdominal pain, diarrhea, malnutrition and fatigue. Anti-inflammatory drugs and immune system suppressors help in long term remission.

Symptoms

Symptoms range from mild to severe and include:

- Abdominal pain and tenderness
- Feeling of a filled abdomen
- Tiredness
- Diarrhea, which can be mixed with blood, mucus or pus in severe cases
- Constipation
- Nausea
- Weight loss
