This is an interesting study about the retroperitoneoscopic approach for partial nephrectomy in children with duplex kidney. The advantages of the laparoscopic approach mainly include a comprehensive exposure to the anatomy of the kidney and its blood vessels, an ability to easily suture the kidney in vivo and an ability to easily identify the nonfunctional kidney, which are crucial steps in this operation. In this study, the case of a 9-year-old child with hydronephrosis of the left kidney is well described and well discussed. The operation procedure of the patient is very clearly shown in Figure 3. The retroperitoneoscopic approach for partial nephrectomy is feasible and effective in selective pediatric patients with a duplex kidney. Only some minor language polishing should be corrected.
