Comment: This study is very interesting. Only the title is too long, and a minor language revision is required.

Comment #1. In the method section, the inclusion criteria is in detail and very clear. Are there any exclusion criteria? Please make a statement.

Response: Thank you for your valuable advise. We are sorry for not list the exclusion criteria specifically. The exclusion criteria was "Defecography, colonoscopy, transmission test, and rectal and canal manometry were performed to exclude slow transit constipation, rectal or colorectal carcinoma, complete rectal prolapse, enterocoele, inflammatory bowel disease, severe fecal incontinence, and pelvic floor dyssynergia. Patients with an ODS score < 10 or a

depth of rectocele<2.0cm, which was shown on defecography were not recruited in our study” , which was mentioned in the inclusion criteria but not listed independently. Moreover, patients who failed to keep up to the follow-up and those patients who hadn't receive any medical treatment before were excluded from our trial, which was mentioned in the revised manuscript. We have polished the statement of the exclusion criteria listed it independently in our new manuscript.

Comment #2 The follow up is good, are there any plans to make a continued follow up? The results are well discussed. And the limit of this study is also listed and discussed. Any plans for a larger number of patients, a multiple center study, and a longer-term follow-up to further prove the effectiveness and safety?

Response: Thank you for your thoughtful advise. We have planned to further detect the safety and effectiveness of our procedure with a longer period follow-up, larger number of patients and a multiple center trial. This plan was mentioned in the revised manuscript.
