SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The manuscript by Yoichiro Okubo makes a general appraisal of how the similarities between gangliocytic paragangliomas (GP) and neuroendocrine tumors grade 1 (NET G1) may lead to overtreatment of GP. Specifically, they evaluate previous meta-analyses from the author's group and suggest that the immunohistochemistry aspects may help



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to differentiate these two entities, and therefore, less aggressive treatment should be employed for GP. This is a well-written and timely editorial of a neglected topic. The title reflects the main subject of the manuscript as well as the abstract summarizes and reflects the work described in the manuscript. The editorial adequately describes the background, present status and significance of the study and it interprets the literature adequately, highlighting the key points concisely, clearly and logically. My concern is that the author describes a whole range of differences between GP and NET G1, many of which may be unfamiliar to the general readership of World Journal of Clinical Oncology, which is the target audience. The authors could enhance the manuscript by including a summary figure or table that recapitulates the major differences, as it would pull together the conceptual framework of the editorial convey.
