The author should include and comment the recent review on mechanisms of chemoresistance in gastric cancer PMID 26234359. 4. Some abbreviations are defined in table 1 legend, but they must be also defined at their first appearance in the text.

The methodology of the study has not been highlighted in a standardized way. I would suggest a better description, hence writing a methodology. In conclusion, this article by n-Hwan et al. covers an interesting topic. The study did a comprehensive summary on the adjuvant therapy in patients with advanced gastric cancer. However, there was no



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added value on this topic. N-Hwan et al. only compared between three oncologic protocols. Moreover the results in western adjuvant therapy can not be directly compared to the Asian findings because on the preceded surgical approach Therefore I would suggest minor revision of the study.

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
