**SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

The authors report a case of PPP syndrome. Even though a rare, it is a know entity and it will be interesting to know how the current reported case is different from what has already been published in literature and if the current case provides any additional



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information. Additional comments: - would recommend using better/improved quality images for PET scan and MRI - label with arrows what authors want to show. - recommend deleting ERCP image as it is not adding any information - recommend deleting lipase/amylase level as these levels are not routinely tested to check improvement or worsening of acute pancreatitis. - recommend discussing if endoscopic guidance of pseudocyst was considered. - recommend detailing on how fistula between pseudocyst and superior IVC was managed (this could be used as a focal point of the current case report).

1. The authors described a patient with PPP syndrome caused by fistula formation between the inferior vena cava (IVC) and pancreatic pseudocyst. 2. Generally speaking, the quality of the current manuscript is good. The future direction is design a corhort



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study to find the syndrome's dependent risk factor. 3.The limitation is that the precise cause of the complications was not discussed in details. The publication could trigger the basic and clinical study.
