This paper is a well written article on a rare condition in adult bringing to the readers

valuable information on a large number of patients selected by the review of histology. It is a long time single center experience as was mentioned in the title. The abstract is correctly summarizing the findings of the study. The Introduction put us in the field of giant cell hepatitis with differences between children and adults explaining the importance of the study. The Methods are properly designed for the aim of the study. I did not understand the doctors who evaluated the data (B, M, M? as the last name of the authors are M, C, R, M, M). The Results are properly presented, using tables and one figure. As is a descriptive study there is basic statistics; it seems there is no difference between the group of native and allograft liver (no analysis for that). The Discussions presents the findings of this analysis in corroboration with other few report in the literature. There are mentioned also the limitations of the study (retrospective, descriptive study) and the strength, as the largest number of cases from a single center were analysed. The Conclusions are clear, based on the data revealed by this study. References are well interpreted and used, having in mind the rarity of the diagnosis there are scarce data in the literature. It is an important paper for the field as it put a light in this rare condition for adult, emphasizing the need of a high index of suspicion for the diagnosis. There is no doubt about the use of the English language as there are native speakers and I am not in the position of improving this as my English is foreign language. Based on all of this I consider that the paper is well written, is dealing with an important field, even or because this is a rare condition in adult, and could be published without structural changes.
