Very interesting case report of hepatic amyloidosis combined with hepatic venular occlusive disease and Budd-Chiari syndrome. Hepatic venous occlusion, also known as sinus space obstruction syndrome, is a non-thrombotic obstruction of hepatic circulation

that is accompanied by lobular central sinus space fibrosis and common hepatic venular fibrosis stenosis or occlusion. Hepatic amyloidosis along with HVOD and Budd-Chiari syndrome is relatively rare clinically; therefore no study has been reported to date. The manuscript is very well written. Figures are clear. The Chief complaint section should be checked and revised. The history of the disease should be removed under a single subtitle. Some minor language polsihing should be corrected.
