Reviewer: 1 Comments to the Author

1.1 - The case is well described, but from my point of view, it is important to expand the description of different therapeutic options, including fluid replacement, antibiotics, mesalamine and corticosteroids (prednisone, budesonide, etc.). It is also recommended to add possible serious complications, including gastrointestinal bleeding, perforations, embolism, colonic rupture, etc., described in the literature. Recent literature references also will not be superfluous [Offenbacher J. et al., 2019, Lee JS, Yoo JK, 2018]. The manuscript can be recommended for publication after a minor revision.

Authors' Response: We thank the reviewer for the useful comments. We have made changes in the discussion section. Highlighted section in the discussion shows the added comments about steroid use and other described complications with chemical colitis. One of the references [Offenbacher J. et al., 2019] as suggested has been added, the other reference [Lee JS, Yoo JK, 2018] was previously there in the manuscript but now has been removed as we noticed that this particular manuscript has now been withdrawn from Pubmed.
