within the stomach and intestine is resistant to digestion, which occasionally presents as trichobezoar-induced bowel or gastric outlet obstruction. Most of the trichobezoars are usually found in young females between 15 and 20 years of age because of their nonspecific presentations or even lack of clinical symptoms in the early stage. This case in this study is very rare, and the manuscript is well written. Comments: 1 The manuscript requires an editing, both the language and the style. Some minor language polishing should be reviewed, and the style of the structure should be updated according to the guideline of the journal. 2 Are there any follow up data after the girl out of hospital? 3 Discussion is performed well with updated references.
