^b The major difference between EC (perihilar cholangiocarcinoma) and GC staging system in UICC manual (same with AJCC): a lesion would be staged as T3-4 of GC if beyond the serosa of biliary wall, but would not be staged as T3-4 of EC unless invading the portal vein, artery, or the second-order biliary system
