Reviewer comment:

This case is interesting and seems reportable. However, the authors should add further information, especially for the treatment selection of this patient. According to the disease stage, patient age, histology of the tumor, molecular and chromosomal information, the patient seems to be classified as low risk group of INRG risk classification. In this group, surgical resection or surgical resection with low dose chemotherapy should be applied to minimize adverse effects of chemotherapy. Please clarify the treatment strategy or selection in your institute more precisely (for example; citing a protocol reference or presenting the dose of anti-tumor drugs) in the text.

Response: We cite a new reference from Chinese Children's Cancer Cooperative Group study about children's neuroblastoma (CCCG-NB-2015), and present the anti-tumor drugs and the doses. *Thank you.*
