The X-ray **report** showed presence of a radiolucent area in his right femur. An **assay** of his **parathyroid hormone**, Sestamibi scan and ultrasound scan of his neck were done. The elevated **parathyroid hormone** level, increased **serum calcium**, history of fractures and X-ray features indicated the diagnosis of Primary **Hyperparathyroidism**.
