Firstly, Thanks for your comments.

The reviewer suggested that “it’s necessary to explain your diagnostic way to malignant neoplastic lesion. Can there be the malignant hepatic tumors, in particular the more frequent hepatocellular carcinoma, without peripheral vascular contrast enhancement in CT scan? And also what are the characteristic features of unusual hepatic tumors on CT, MRI examination?”

1. We add the “The typical CT image of hepatocellular carcinoma was enhanced at the early stage”
2. In the hepatocellular carcinoma, there are peripheral vascular contrast enhancement in CT scan.
3. For the unusual hepatic tumors, such as liver metastasis of gastric cancer, the image feature was delayed enhanced, “Bull eye sign”.
