This review was done in an amicable and thorough manner given the paucity of the available published data on transgender treatment outcomes. The study mainly focused on transmen and transwomen in Europe especially Belgium and the Netherlands. Also, it was a systematic review of the subject in a retrospective fashion. Therefore, the parameters and limitations of the studies reviewed were apparent at the start. However, until more prospective studies can be conducted, this review brings to focus the available knowledge on the long-term effects of hormonal treatment.
