Mar 25, 2018 · An interim analysis at week 24 in **patients** receiving only Myrcludex B showed ALT normalization in 6 **patients** and **HDV RNA** decrease greater than 1 log in 4 **patients** (mean **change** from baseline, 10 1.67), with clearance in 2; however, the **levels of HBsAg** were unchanged in all **patients**. After cessation of therapy, HDV RNA reappeared in all **patients**.
