## Review of source-monitoring processes in obsessive-compulsive disorder

### Abstract

Obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD) is a severe mental illness characterized by persistent, intrusive and distressing obsessions and/or compulsions. Such symptoms have been conceptualized as resulting from a failure in source-monitoring processes, suggesting that patients with OCD fail to distinguish actions they perform from those they just imagine doing. In this study, we aimed to provide an updated and exhaustive review of the literature examining the relationship between source-monitoring and OCD. A systematic search in the literature through January 2019 allowed us to identify

## Obsessive Compulsive Disorder

Medical Condition



A mental health disorder characterized by repetitive actions that seem impossible to stop.

- Very common (More than 3 million cases per year in US)
- Often requires lab test or imaging
- Treatment from medical professional advised
- Can last several years or be lifelong

The cause of OCD is not known, but genetic changes and family history have been noted in some cases. Symptoms are either obsession or compulsion, or both. It is treated by either medication or psychotherapy, or both.

### Symptoms

- Symptoms can be either obsessions or compulsions, or both
- Symptoms can be mild and gradually progress in severity
- Stress worsens the symptoms
- Persistent, repeated and unwanted thoughts
- Urges or images that are intrusive
- Compulsive or ritualistic behavior to get rid of the thoughts
