(1) The plain abdominal film findings could be described (presumably multiple small bowel loops) rather than

the single interpretative statement.

→ Abdominal X-ray showed paralytic ileus, with multiple small bowel loops and fecal densities in colon.

(2) Did the CT actually demonstrate a mesenteric perforation? Or changes suggestive of this?

→ The CT scan showed a small quantity of free air with mesentery, suggesting microperforation of small bowel.

(3) The authors should add an arrow (or two) to Figure 1 (of the CT) to guide readers to the location of the

changes evident.

(4) Similarly, Figure 3 needs an arrow to guide readers.
