Reviewer #1: This review is focused on an important and current topic within the set of BE treatment, concerning the therapeutic options for patients refractory to radio frequency ablation. The manuscript is well organized and exhaustive. In particular I have appreciated the last part on the cryotherapy, hybrid APC and endorotor Endoscopic resection, which are relatively new approach to this problem. Few study on these novel technique are available and the authors synthesize current available notions and point reader's attention on the future perspective with a good iconography and examples of possible uses. I think that this review perfectly respect the aims of the journal.

I have only few minor comments: Anti-reflux surgery paragraph, first sentence. The use of the verb remains twice in the same sentence is not effective. Perhaps a different verb can be chosen to remark the concept in the second part of the sentence.
