Background; The first sentence should be as follows "mostly occurs in the major or intraoral minor salivary glands." Case Summary; The first sentence should be changed as "A 39-year-old woman with a mass located in the right submandibular area presented to our department." The authors should control the grammar in this sentence; "Physical examination revealed lymphadenopathy of the right submandibular lymph nodes, measuring 2.5×3 cm, that was tender, hard, and had poor mobility." Introduction: "MEC has been classified as low-, intermediate-, and high-grade tumors." The word "tumors" should be removed. Discussion; What kind of radiotherapy was used for the patient? What was the duration of radiotherapy? The authors should explain these matters at the end of Discussion section.
